Notice of Public Hearings

The District has resolved to change the way in which it elects members of its Board of Directors. Beginning in 2020, the District will elect members of the Board from zones within the District, as opposed to at-large as it does now.

The public is invited to participate in five (5) public hearings listed below and to provide input in creating five (5) election zones that comply with both the Federal and California Voting Rights Acts. The purpose of the first two public hearings (January 15, 2020 and February 6, 2020) is to gather public input on the composition, population, geography and communities of interest in the District's service area and jurisdiction. Following these two initial meetings, with the help of a demographer, the District will present one or more draft maps of five (5) potential election zones, which are compliant with both the Federal and California Voting Rights Acts for consideration and public input at the February 19, 2020 and the March 4, 2020 public hearings. The public hearings listed in the schedule below will be held at the North Coast County Water District office at 2400 Francisco Blvd. in Pacifica.
