SHEILA TANK REPLACEMENT PROJECT CONSTRUCTION TO RESUME IN MAY

This letter serves to provide you with notification of construction activity for Sheila Tank Replacement Project. Due to unforeseen issues and inclement weather, the Project was delayed for several months and additional design work was performed. The construction work will be commencing soon, starting with the installation of new water piping on Alvarado Avenue at the base of the water tank site. After that work is complete, the contractor will proceed with construction of the new 600,000-gallon prestressed concrete tank, new access road, valve vault, and additional piping connections. Further schedule updates will be provided in the coming weeks.

The District's contractor, Anderson Pacific Construction Engineering, Inc, is scheduled to begin work installing water pipelines on Alvarado Ave on **Monday, May 1 2023**. The work on Alvarado Ave is anticipated to last approximately 6 weeks.

All work is being performed on District property and access to residential properties will be maintained at all times. Work has been limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
