PRVs IMPROVEMENT PROJECT CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN MAY 30

This letter serves to provide you with notification of construction activity for the Pressure Reducing Valves (PRV) Improvement Project. Construction work will begin soon, starting with the installation of a belowground concrete vault near the intersection of Adobe Drive and Higgins Way. After that work is complete, the contractor will proceed with installation of pipelines to connect the vault to the water distribution system. Further schedule updates will be provided in the coming weeks.

The District's contractor, Anderson Pacific Construction Engineering, Inc, is scheduled to begin work on **Tuesday, May 30, 2023**. The work is anticipated to last approximately 3 weeks.

Access to residential properties will be maintained at all times. Work has been limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
