## SHEILA TANK REPLACEMENT PROJECT NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Dear Residents,

This letter serves to provide you with notification that construction activity for the Sheila Tank Replacement Project (1139 Sheila Lane) has resumed. As you may be aware, certain components of the Project were delayed for several months as additional design work was performed. As of August 17, 2023, the District's contractor, Anderson Pacific Construction Engineering, Inc., has begun earthwork to construct a temporary access road, a temporary crane pad, and permanent retaining wall at the site. Once that work is complete, the contractor will proceed with construction of the new 600,000-gallon prestressed concrete tank (estimated November 2023 through May 2024). Final site work will include installation of valve vault and piping connections, final site grading, and site paving and fencing. The work is anticipated to last approximately 14 months, weather permitting, with an estimated completion date of October 2024.

Access to residential properties will continue to be maintained at all times. Work has been limited to the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.
