North Coast County Water District's smart meters provide real-time accuracy to help you better understand your household water use. Here's how to make sense of water measurements on your meter report.

Water Meter Water Usage



MEASURED IN

CF

1 CF = 1 CUBIC FOOT

DISPLAYED IN

CF

1 CF = 7.48 GALLONS

Convert to Gallons

MULTIPLY BY

7.48

TO GET CF IN GALLONS

EXAMPLE

WATER METER

100 CF

x7.48

CONVERTS TO

748 Gallons

TOILET

Per flush

1.3-5 gallons

0.17 - 0.67 CF



BATHTUB

Average tub filled

30-50 gallons

4-6.7 CF



SHOWERHEAD

5-minute shower

9-25 gallons

1.2 - 3.3 CF



WASHING MACHINE

Per cycle per cubic foot

7-40 gallons

0.94-5.3 CF



SINK FAUCET

Per minute usage

½ - 3 gallon

0.07 - 0.4 CF



DISHWASHER

Per cycle

3-15 gallons

0.4-2 CF
